

SUSS Strides 2026

Participation Terms and Conditions

The **SUSS Strides 2026 event (the “Event”)** is organised by **Singapore University of Social Sciences (the “Organiser”)**.

By registering for, attending, or participating in the Event, and/or using the Event website, you agree to be bound by these Terms and Conditions. These Terms and Conditions are a legally binding agreement between you and the Organiser with respect to the Event.

The Organiser reserves the right to amend these Terms and Conditions at any time. Any such amendments shall take effect upon publication.

A. REGISTRATION AND FEES

1. Registration must be completed via the official online Event registration form.
2. A confirmation email will be issued upon successful registration.
3. Registration fees are strictly non-refundable.

B. ACTIVITY SUBMISSION AND TRACKING

1. Participants may submit multiple activities throughout the period specified by the Organiser (“Challenge Period”).
2. Distances completed across multiple activity sessions will be accumulated towards each participant’s overall challenge goal.
3. Participants may track and submit activities under the following categories:
 - (a) Walk;
 - (b) Run;
 - (c) Cycle; and
 - (d) Swim.
4. All activities must be recorded using a GPS-enabled fitness tracking application or an activity tracking platform from the following list:
 - (a) Strava;
 - (b) Garmin Connect;
 - (c) Nike Run Club;
 - (d) Runkeeper;
 - (e) Map My Run / Map My Ride;
 - (f) Adidas Running;
 - (g) Apple Health;

- (h) Google Fit;
 - (i) Fitbit; and
 - (j) Wahoo.
- 5. Other GPS-enabled fitness tracking applications or activity tracking platforms may be accepted, subject to verification and approval by the Organiser.
- 6. Each activity submission must clearly show the following details:
 - (a) Date of activity;
 - (b) Distance completed; and
 - (c) Duration of activity.
- 7. The Organiser reserves the right to verify all submitted activities and reject any submissions that do not comply with these Terms and Conditions.

C. ACTIVITY VERIFICATION AND DISQUALIFICATION

- 1. The following activity submissions will not be accepted:
 - (a) Photos of fitness watches or fitness devices without supporting activity records;
 - (b) Manual entries without supporting activity data;
 - (c) Edited, altered or incomplete screenshots;
 - (d) Activities recorded outside the Challenge Period; and
 - (e) Duplicate submissions of the same activity.
- 2. The Organiser reserves the right to disqualify any participant or submission that does not comply with these Terms and Conditions.
- 3. The Organiser's decision on all matters relating to the Event, including activity submissions, verification, eligibility and redemption, shall be final.

D. PARTICIPANT CONDUCT AND SAFETY

- 1. Participants must comply with all instructions, safety requirements, and directions issued by the Organiser.
- 2. Participants attend and participate in the Event activities at their own risk.
- 3. Participants are expected to behave in a respectful and appropriate manner at all times in relation to their participation in the Event activities. Harassment, discrimination, or disruptive behaviour will not be tolerated.
- 4. The Organiser reserves the right to remove or disqualify any participant whose behaviour is deemed by the Organiser to be unsafe, inappropriate, or disruptive, without refund.

E. INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

1. You retain ownership of any media, materials or other submissions (“Submission”) submitted to the Organiser for purposes of the Event.
2. You grant the Organiser a non-exclusive, royalty-free licence to use, reproduce and/or display the Submission for purposes related to the Event.
3. You represent and warrant that: (a) you have the necessary right, licence and consent to grant the foregoing licence; and (b) your Submission does not infringe the intellectual property or other rights (including confidential information or trade secrets) of any third party.

F. DISCLAIMERS

1. The Event and any related services or materials are provided on an “as is” and “as available” basis.
2. The Organiser makes no representations or warranties of any kind, whether express or implied, to the fullest extent permitted by law.
3. The Organiser reserves the right to modify, postpone or cancel the Event or any part of it at any time, in its sole and absolute discretion, without prior notice to you.

G. PERSONAL DATA AND PRIVACY

1. By registering for and/or participating in the Event, you agree that the Organiser may collect, use and disclose your personal data for the following purposes:
 - (a) Processing and administering your registration and participation;
 - (b) Communicating with you regarding the Event;
 - (c) Processing payments, where applicable;
 - (d) Responding to your queries;
 - (e) Obtaining feedback;
 - (f) Tracking your participation and activities, verifying your submitted activities, maintaining and publishing leaderboards (where applicable), and documenting, publicising and reporting on the Event;
 - (g) Sending information on future events organised by the Organiser, subject to your preferences indicated in the registration form; and
 - (h) The purposes set out in Paragraph H.
2. The Organiser may disclose your personal data to its agents, service providers and/or partners for the foregoing purposes.

3. All personal data will be handled in accordance with applicable laws, including the Personal Data Protection Act 2012, and [SUSS' Privacy Statement](#) and [Personal Data Protection Notice](#).
4. You may withdraw your consent at any time by contacting the Organiser's Data Protection Officer at dpo@suss.edu.sg. Withdrawal of consent will not affect any prior collection, use or disclosure of your personal data.

H. MEDIA CONSENT

1. During the Event, the Organiser or its authorised representatives may receive from you or capture images, photographs, audio and/or video recordings.
2. By agreeing to these Terms and Conditions, you consent to:
 - (a) Being photographed, filmed and/or recorded during the Event; and
 - (b) The Organiser's collection and use of your name and any images, photographs, audio or video recordings, or other media that you submit or that are captured during the Event and that contain your personal data, including your image, likeness and/or voice.
3. The Organiser may use such materials for the purposes of documenting, promoting and reporting on the Event, and for publicity, marketing, internal reporting, donor engagement and other purposes relating to the Event, across such media and communication platforms as the Organiser may determine, including (without limitation) websites, social media, newsletters, publications, advertisements, promotional videos, educational materials and other associated communication channels, in any format now known or subsequently developed. You acknowledge that no additional compensation, notification or further permission shall be required for such authorised use.
4. If you do not consent to the collection and use of your personal data as described in this Paragraph H, or if you wish to withdraw your consent, you must notify the Organiser in writing at annualgiving@suss.edu.sg. Withdrawal of consent will apply prospectively and will not affect any collection, use or disclosure that took place before the Organiser received and processed your request.
5. Participants who do not consent, or who subsequently withdraw their consent, will be reasonably accommodated where practicable. However, the Organiser does not guarantee that such participants will not be incidentally captured in group or background recordings.

6. Where you submit any image, photograph, video or audio recording, or other media that contains the personal data (including the image, likeness or voice) of any individual other than yourself, you represent and warrant that you have notified such individual(s) and have obtained all necessary consents, or are otherwise authorised under applicable law, to provide such personal data to the Organiser for the purposes set out in these Terms and Conditions. Where such individual is below the age at which they may lawfully give consent, you represent and warrant that the necessary consent has been obtained from the individual's parent or legal guardian.

I. INDEMNITY AND LIMITATION OF LIABILITY

1. You acknowledge that participation in the Event involves inherent risks, including the risk of loss, damage, injury, illness, accident, death or property damage. To the fullest extent permitted by law, the Organiser, its officers, faculty, students, employees, representatives, agents, partners, sponsors and any other persons involved in organising the Event shall not be liable for any loss, damage, injury, illness, accident, death or property damage arising out of or in connection with your participation in the Event, except to the extent caused by the negligence or wilful misconduct of the Organiser.
2. You agree to indemnify and hold harmless the Organiser against any actions, proceedings, claims, demands, losses, damages, costs, legal costs and other expenses of any nature which may be made or brought against, or suffered or incurred by, the Organiser, whether directly or indirectly, arising out of or in connection with your participation in the Event or any breach by you of these Terms and Conditions, except to the extent that such actions, proceedings, claims, demands, losses, damages, costs, legal costs or other expenses are caused by the negligence or wilful misconduct of the Organiser.
3. The Organiser shall not be responsible or liable for any loss, damage or injury arising from or in connection with any gift, reward or item issued in connection with the Event.
4. The Organiser shall not be liable for any special, indirect, incidental or consequential damages, including but not limited to loss of profits, revenue, contracts, anticipated savings or business, pure economic loss, loss or corruption of data, loss of opportunity and/or expectation loss.

5. To the extent permitted by law, the Organiser's total liability to you shall not exceed the fees paid in relation to the Event, whether arising in contract, tort (including negligence), or otherwise.

J. THIRD PARTIES

1. Your participation in the Event may require you to accept or enter into other agreements with third parties (e.g. content and/or other service providers) involved in the Event. These third parties are not the Organiser's agents and the Organiser is not responsible for their actions or omissions. Any arrangements with such third parties are solely between you and the third party.

K. GENERAL PROVISIONS

1. These Terms and Conditions constitute the entire agreement between you and the Organiser in relation to the Event and supersede any other representations or arrangements relating to the Event.
2. Paragraphs B.7, C, D.4, E, F, G, H, I, J and K, and such provisions as are intended by their nature to survive, shall survive the conclusion of the Event or the termination of these Terms and Conditions.
3. If any provision of these Terms and Conditions is found to be invalid or unenforceable, the remaining provisions shall remain in full force and effect. Any waiver of a party's rights shall be in writing and shall not prevent the party's further exercise of the same or any other right.
4. No person who is not a party to these Terms and Conditions shall have any right to enforce any provision under the Contracts (Rights of Third Parties) Act 2001.
5. These Terms and Conditions shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of Singapore.
6. Any disputes arising out of or in connection with the Event shall be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the Singapore Courts.
